## Route 3 - Mill route (3 hours)

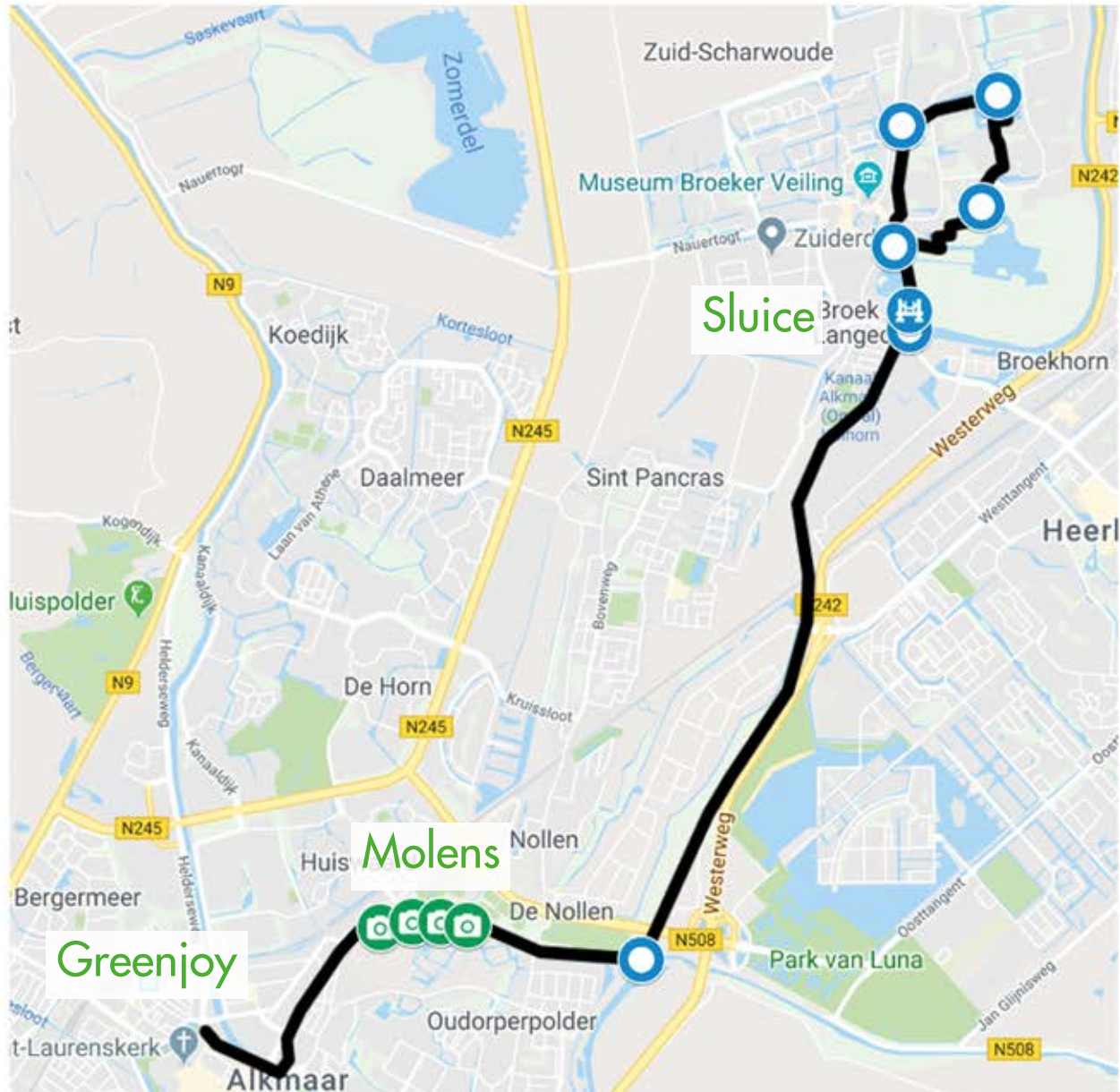
Combine the city centre with a boat trip along the various mills and the Oudorp polder district.

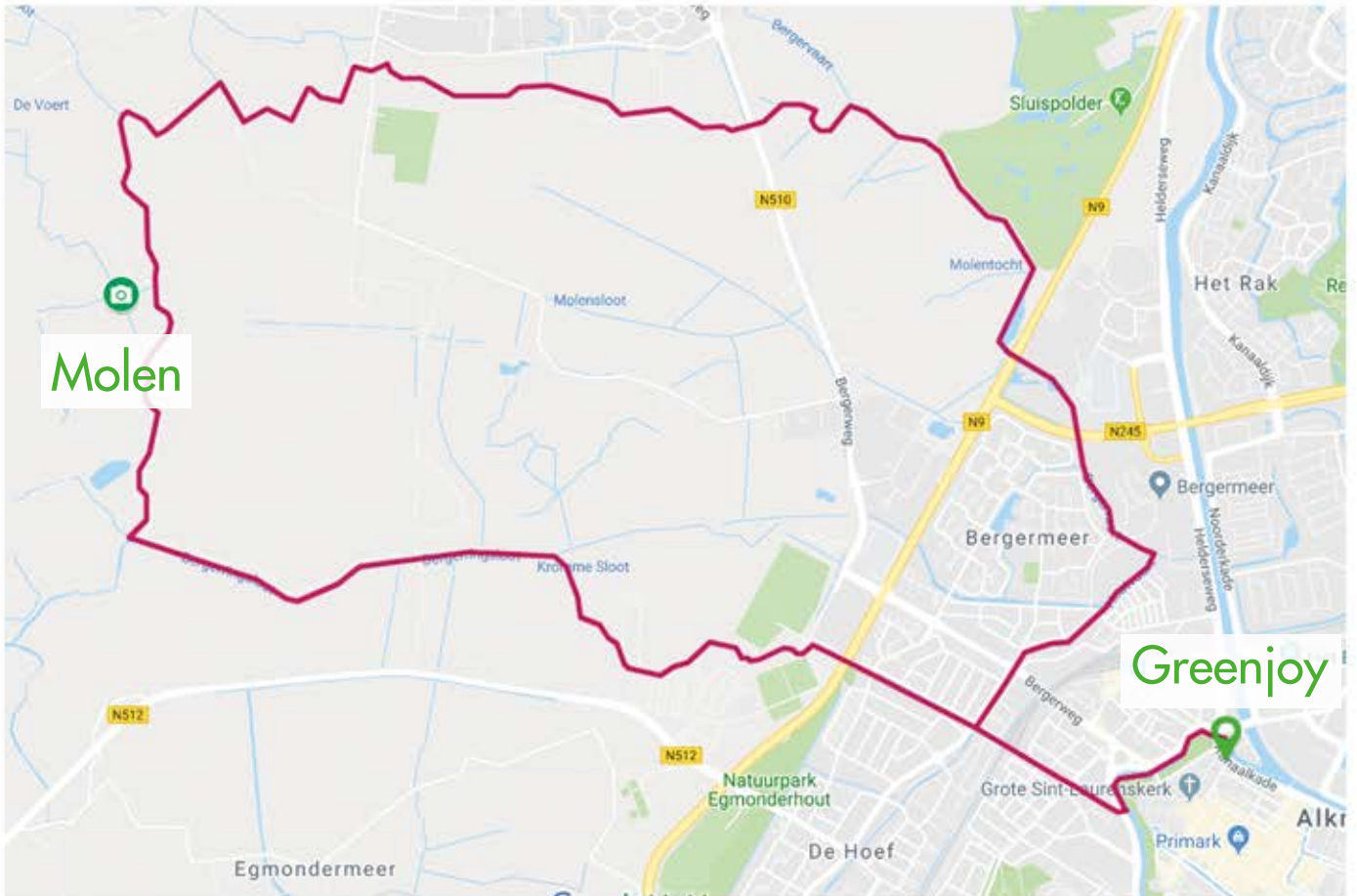


Route 4 - The 1000 islands area (at least 5 hours)

Langedijk is located just above Alkmaar, the surrounding area consists of a maze of ditches and canals with which the growers could reach their fields in this area. It is really a beautiful phenomenon to sail through. Please note: the boat trip to the sluice at Broek op Langedijk alone takes approximately 2 hours. At the sluice it can take up to around 30 minutes. So keep this in mind for the way back. (October 16 to April 15, telephone appointment for the sluice only)
