Route 1 - Grachtenroute (2 hours)

There is much to see

Sail from the
Greenjoy location
towards the
Weerdsluis and sail
into the Oudegracht
along the many
terraces. At Ledig
Erf you will come up
to the Singel again
and keep left.

Sail past the
Sterrenwacht back
to the Greenjoy
location at the
Wittevrouwensingel.

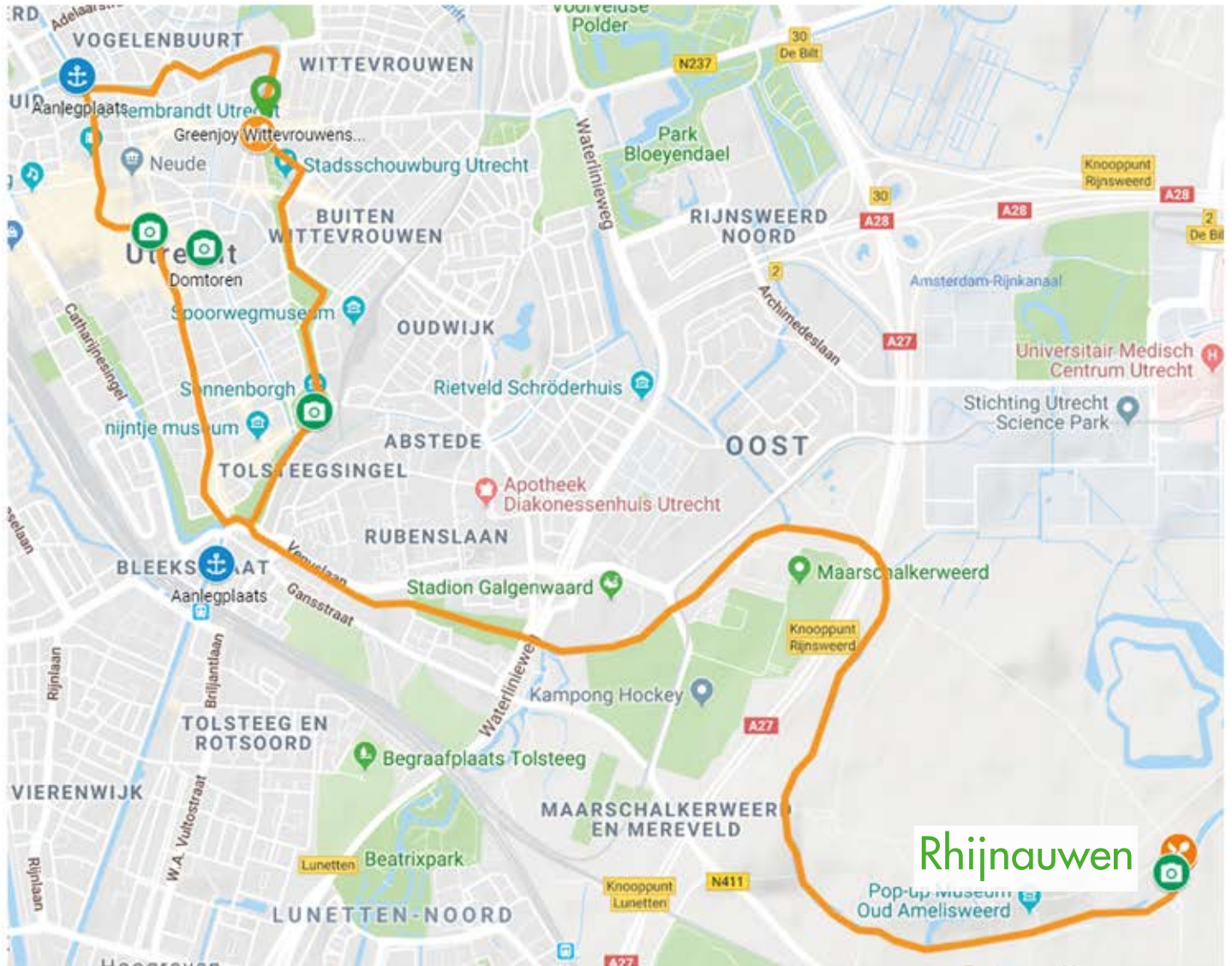
(To extend the cruise
a little, you can sail
over the newly

Catharijnesingel)

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Route 2 - Kromme Rijn route (4 hours, 5 hours with break)



If you sail for at least 4 hours and you prefer to go out into nature, you can head up the Kromme Rijn at Ledig Erf (note that this is not the Wester- / Oosterkade which is an extension of the Oudegracht). You automatically enter the Rhijnauwen nature reserve, where you can only sail with an electric boat. At the famous Theehuis Rhijnauwen you can have a nice pit stop with a little snack and then sail back to the city.

Note: Due to the current you have to take two hours to the Theehuis and one hour back on the Kromme Rijn.
